They still stand as one beautiful building with exquisite stained-glass windows, high arched ceilings, and intricate wood detailing. But more importantly, for the last 45 years of our 85 years of existence this church continues to serve as a place of refuge, worship, and fellowship for us and for the people of Glenville and neighboring communities.

No doubt, we have had our challenges maintaining the building’s upkeep, but overall, we have done well with this task. However, the past and present winters have shown us that we need to do more. Financing two new furnaces, replacing many of the windows in the church and Parish House where our offices, conference rooms, and gym are located and merging our two lots into one parking lot with fencing are immediate needs.

To minister to the needs of the church and the community more properly we must take care of these matters. We need your help.
